

Oregon Joint Use Association Oregon's Utility Provider Maps

USING THE OREGON'S UTILITY PROVIDERS MAPS

The maps available on this site have been created in two formats--*.dwg* files and *.dwf* files.

The *.dwg* maps were created using the Autodesk MAP program. They can be viewed and printed using both the **Autodesk MAP** program and **Autodesk AutoCAD** program.

The *.dwf* maps can be viewed and printed using the **Autodesk Viewer** program, which is available as a free download at <http://usa.autodesk.com>.

The maps have been broken up into 6 separate maps. All maps include the OregonBase map.

1. The OregonBase map
 - a. This map is the building block for all the other maps.
 - b. This map includes all info not relating to a utility provider.
 - c. Township and Range are also on this map.
2. The Oregon_CATV_Providers map
 - a. This map covers CATV operators
3. The Oregon_Telco_Providers map
 - a. This map covers TELCO operators
4. The Oregon_Power_Providers map
 - a. This map covers POWER operators
5. The Oregon_Other_Providers map
 - a. This map covers OTHER operators
6. The Oregon_ALL_Providers map
 - a. This map covers ALL providers put together onto one map for overlay purposes.

USING THE AUTODESK VIEWER

For layer functions, select *View* on the menu bar then select *Layers*.

The *Layers* window appears, showing all the layers on the map.

To turn layers on or off, click on the light bulb located left of the layer name.

A lit bulb means the layer is turned on, and a dark bulb means it is turned off

The easiest way to zoom in and out is with the roller on your mouse.

There are also *Zoom Rectangle* and *Fit to Window* buttons on the tool bar.

To print an entire map:

1. Select *File* on the menu bar then select *Print*.
2. In the *Print* window select the printer you wish to print to.
3. In the *Print What* section select *Full Page*.
4. Select the desired *Paper Size and Orientation, Reduce/Enlarge Drawing, Print Range*, and *Copies* options.
5. Select *Print*.

To print a specific section of any map (e.g. a particular township and range):

1. Zoom the map to the area you wish to print
2. Follow the above print direction, except select *Current View* instead of *Full Page*.
3. This will only print what is visible on your screen at the time you select print.
The maps were converted to .dwf files in a D size format for ease of printing large maps as well as smaller maps.
