## **Approval of Minutes**

<u>Motion</u>: Moved by Jerry Donovan and seconded by Todd Gover to accept the minutes of the March 19, 2014 meeting as presented. **Motion passed**.

#### **Grandfathering Matrix**

The Committee reviewed the Grandfathering Matrix. John Wallace emphasized the OPUC's opposition to Exception B under NESC Rule 232 relating to vertical clearances. John believes the wrong footnote 8 is being used to draw the conclusion when it should be footnote 7. The Committee discussed the differing opinions and how they were arrived at.

*By consensus*, the Committee agreed not to present the Matrix to the OJUA Board or Executive Committee pending further work.

The Committee agreed to address a typographical error under 234 C (changing "neatest" to "nearest"). They also discussed NESC Rule 235 (5b); 235 H1 and 235 H2 and made minor changes. Staff will make those changes and re-send a new copy. (EXHIBIT A)

### **Decorative Street Lights**

Committee members discussed a meeting regarding streetlights sponsored by the City of Portland where Dave Marne was hired to provide instruction. Committee members were asked to forward any additional photos to staff for inclusion in the PowerPoint presentation. Members discussed problems encountered with banner placement.
