Grandfather Matrix

Mark Rettmann suggested that we start with the change proposal form to begin framing the proposal—although no 2022 form is currently available, we will start with a template created from the 2017 change proposal

The Committee discussed the possibility of changing its meeting date to the third Tuesday instead of Wednesday of each month. Staff will send a notice to all committee members to confirm whether or not the proposed change is acceptable.
